What we do at Theatre Camp

- At our summer camp, participants learn acting, singing, and dancing. We create our own versions of classic works, turning them into fun comedies filled with musical numbers.
- We use various theatrical techniques such as games, bodily expression, and improvisations, to help participants to loosen up and gain confidence.
- Everyone is involved in the plays whether as main characters, supporting roles, or as a chorus, all with their corresponding costumes.
- Various workshops will be held where children will have the opportunity to create sets, masks, props, and learn how to do makeup for the plays.
- Children will be separated into groups by age. English proficiency will not be taken into account so that it is not an exclusionary factor. We aim for everyone to integrate and share, regardless of their level.
- The camp will be directed and coordinated by a native professional actress. The monitors are also native professional actors of Face 2 Face Theatre Co.

The Summer Camp culminates with a theatrical performance in the theatre starring the children, where the spectators will be the actors' families and friends.
